

• Airdrie's PeeWee Storm football club lost 24-12 the Bulldogs, Sept. 22 in a game played at McMahon Stadium. Airdrie took a 6-0 lead in the first half thanks to some stellar defence and a 75-yard reception and run for a touchdown by Victor Primeau. "We really surprised them.
