System 1: Treble clef, key signature of one sharp (F#), 2/4 time signature. Chords: G, D7.

System 2: Treble clef, key signature of one sharp (F#), 2/4 time signature. Chords: G, Am, D7, G, G, D, A7. Measure numbers: 6, 7.

A Puncheon Floor is made using split logs, placed round-side down. The edges are flattened using a broad axe before being fitted together. The surface is finished flat with an adze. This makes a good solid dance floor!
