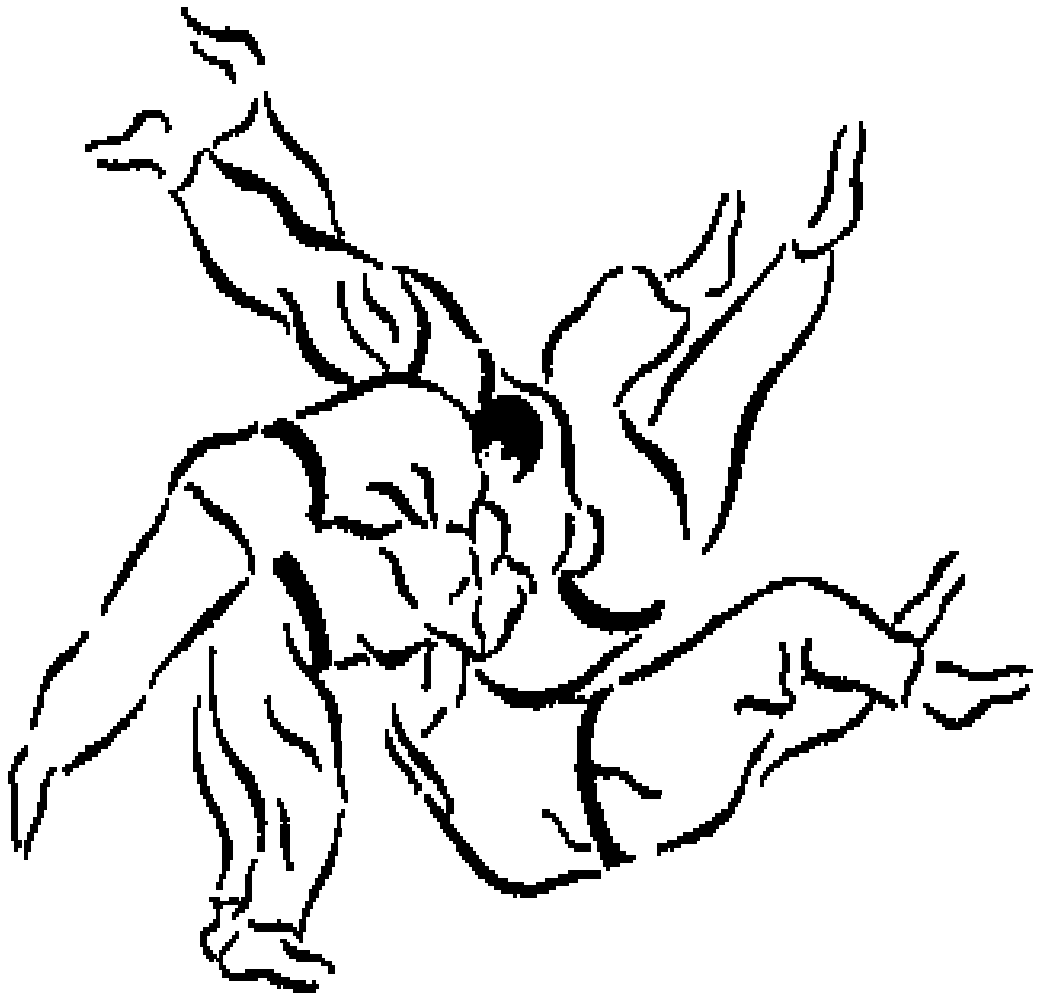

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 per entry when entry list and appropriate fee received by Gary Smith on or before May 7, 2004. (Contestants entering a second division will be charged an additional \$15.00.) Kata: \$10.00 per team. **Any entry fee received after May 7, 2004 will be deemed to be LATE and will be subject to an additional charge of \$10.00 per contestant entered, over and above the entry fee.**

Fax entries will be accepted, but you **must** follow up with a telephone call to confirm the fax entry was received. This confirmation is the responsibility of each club entered. The above noted telephone number has an answering machine.

FOR ENTRIES SENT BY FAX, please send the appropriate fee to reach Gary Smith by May 7, 2004 to ensure no **LATE FEE** is assessed.
NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 10, 2004.

ELIGIBILITY: All participants must be in good standing with their respective Judo organizations. The attached waiver form must be completed and signed by all out-of-province contestants or in case of minors (under 19 years of age) the contestant and parent/guardian must sign the waiver form.

ENTRY LISTS: Please see that each contestant's information be noted completely and accurately on the club's entry list(s), especially the **exact weight**. Refer to "WEIGH-IN" below for \$10.00 change fee.

DRAWS: **Modified double elimination.**

Divisions with three (3) competitors or less will compete in one of the following.

ROUND ROBIN

Three (3) contestants – if tied, by wins first, then by points.

Two (2) contestants – best two out of three wins.

ONE COMPETITOR

May accept medal for their division OR compete in the next higher weight division if they so desire, with permission of their coach.

RULES: I.J.F. Contest Rules will govern the VERNON JUDO TOURNAMENT,

EXCEPT:

- a) divisions 1 to 38: to attempt a "headlock" throw will result in Matte;
- b) divisions 1 to 42: and Divs. 76-81: no shime-waza or kansetsu-waza permitted; attempts will result in a penalty.
- c) **Drop Seoi-Nage WILL NOT** be permitted in all novice division as well in the Juvenile divisions; attempts will result in Hansuko-Make.

In these situations (a, b & c), should a serious injury to the opponent occur, A **Direct Hansoku-Make** will be assessed against the offending contestant. He/she will NOT be permitted to compete in the balance of the tournament.

c) Rest time for competitor for next contest will be 5 minutes.

d) Blue gi is encouraged, to be worn by competitor called first only.

REFERREE

EVALUATION: Provincial “A”, “B”, “C”, and “D” referee evaluations to be held. Those wishing to be evaluated are requested to contact and register with *Seiko Ouchi* prior to the start of the VERNON JUDO TOURNAMENT.

WEIGH-IN: **ALL CONTESTANTS** must weigh in at their designated times for their respective divisions. Divisions are as designated by Judo Canada standard for Juv, Jr. and Senior men and women

PLEASE NOTE: a \$10.00 change fee will be assessed to each contestant failing to make weight for each division(s) entered.

Early weigh-in: FRIDAY, MAY 14, 2004

7:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the tournament site for boys and girls,
Divs. 1 to 38.

We recommend contestants in these divisions take advantage of this early weigh-in.
