



# Park Leg Synopsis

Parent visits part hours ahead and places 8½” x 11” country signs in locations that are out of view but roughly similar in relative proximity to a world map. Each sign has a country image and a table containing country information and various instructions. Below each “country”, a collection of colored ribbons is fastened.

Parent sets perimeter for the game that children will understand. Children are given Roadblock envelopes in 30 second (or less) ordinal delays. The Roadblock requires them to collect a prescribed set of colored ribbons from around the park. Upon presenting the required ribbons to the Host, they are given the Detour envelope.

The Detour envelope requires them to travel to a particular “country” and follow a particular instruction from the list. Instructions require them to move from country to country gathering information and interpreting clues. Instructions are different for each group but of equal difficulty. Their choice is merely in which country to start.

Wildcard Dash involves completing a quiz – the answers of which are found on the various Country Signs.

Estimated Time: 45 – 75 minutes  
Ordinal Delays: 30 seconds or less  
Adults required: 2 (more if park is busy or children young)

## Supplies

### For each team...

- Roadblock Envelope with Instructions
- Roadblock Collection Bag (eg Ziploc freezer bag)
- Detour Envelope with Instructions
- Wildcard Envelope with Instructions
- Pencil

### Additional supplies...

- Country Signs (12)
- Ribbon – 4 or more colors, several yards of each
- Staple gun, tape, several rubber bands
- Large manila envelope

## Preparation

1. Prepare Roadblocks and envelopes with Collection Bags, ribbons
2. Prepare Country Signs, Detour Instructions and envelopes
3. Prepare Wildcards and envelopes
4. Prepare Finish Mat
5. Visit park and place country sheets and ribbons in appropriate locations
