Camp Mission Statement

To provide an opportunity for campers to develop physically, emotionally, and spiritually in a safe and Christian environment. To enable campers to have fun and adventure in a setting of nature, God's creation. To further the outdoor ministry of the United Church of Canada.

A DAY IN THE LIFE AT CAMP:

Every day of each week, campers participate in a variety of interactive activities. These include:

- Arts and crafts
- Sports
- Kayaking
- Drama & theatre sports
- Canoeing
- Singing
- Swimming
- Campfire
- Nature walks
- Eating in the dining hall
- Games
- Sleeping in the cabins

In addition to the daily program, there is Every Day God Experience (EDGE) during which campers engage in topics related to the world around them and how God fits into our world.

Each camp is administered by eight qualified directors and supported by cabin counsellors (one counsellor for every 5 campers). A registered nurse joins the camp staff each week and all staff has first aid training. The entire leadership team receives training before the start of the children's camp and have all had criminal record checks and have been approved by the Cultus Lake United Church Camp Board of Directors.

TRAINING WEEK (age 14+) June 26-July 1: – Youth must complete training week in order to be considered for a volunteer counsellor position. *Please note: completing this week does not guarantee that you will get a counselling position but there are other opportunities to volunteer as part of the camp crew as well.*



JUNIOR CAMP (ages 10-14) July 3-8 – This is a week where young campers can experience all the same activities that keep campers returning every year...arts and crafts, boating, swimming, camp wide games etc. while also participating in leadership and EDGE. Days are themed and participation is crucial to ensure maximum fun this week.

SAILING CAMP (Limited to 12 campers ages 10-14) JULY 10-14 – In addition to daily camp activities campers will learn sailing fundamentals and at the end of the week sail a boat on their own!

This camp happens during the same week as Beginner's Camp.

BEGINNER'S CAMP (ages 7-9) July 10-15 – This camp is designed for elementary aged campers to have their initial experience with camp. Like all United Church Camps, we offer a safe and monitored environment to try out our camp's daily activities and special events like Talent Night, Cartoon Breakfast, and hanging out in your cabin with your camp friends and counsellors.

TEEN CAMP (ages 13-18) July 17-July 22 – All teen campers are given the opportunity to choose which of the sign-up camp activities they want to participate in each day. Special activities include tubing, spa time, henna (mehndi), song writing, photography, Rockband, and much more!*

** Please leave your cell phones and valuables at home. Cell phones and texting will not be allowed. Every cabin will be provided with an alarm clock to wake up with.*

SONGS, STRINGS AND STEPS CAMP (ages 12-18) JULY 24-29 – Songs, Strings and Steps is an interdisciplinary arts show with music, dance, visual and theatre arts, that showcases professional and amateur talent, and has become a very popular event in the Fraser Valley over the last ten years. Directed by Dr. Calvin Dyck, this camp will provide for fun and enjoyment while preparing for a summer concert to be held at the end of the week. In addition to our regular camp activities (arts and crafts, boating, games, campfire and EDGE) there will be drumming circles, theatre sports, themed meals and activities, individual and group lessons including choreography with Program Coordinator Sylvia Friesen and select professional guests. Please call the camp registrar for audition information for musicians with minimum RCM Grade 5 or above. Music will be provided beforehand so the camper is prepared for the week.

In addition to taking part in the daily camp activities, specialized programming for all groups, and family activities are offered.
