- Take exit #104 (No. 3 Road)
- Follow this road through Yarrow
- Turn RIGHT on Cultus Lake Road
- Go past the waterslides and follow the road around the lake
- About a 10 minute drive from the waterslides, turn RIGHT on Lindell Ave.
- Across from the Lindell store, turn RIGHT

CAMP HISTORY

Cultus Lake United Church Camp (CLUCC) had its beginning in the 1890s as a summer camp, located on the corner of Higginson Road and Chilliwack River Road in Chilliwack.

In the mid 1930s it was sold and the existing camp was established at the south end of Cultus Lake, on land leased from BC Parks.

CAMP PROGRAMS

Camp programs include swimming, canoeing, kayaking, outdoor games, arts and crafts, hiking, campfires, singing worship, and may include overnight hikes and camping (age dependant). Activities are designed to take advantage of our beautiful waterfront and park-like setting. We encourage an appreciation of nature during each camping experience. We work with each child to help them develop new friendships, have fun, and enjoy a spirit of adventure in a Christian setting.

The program for each camp session is designed around age appropriate activities.

CAMP STAFF

Each camp is administered by eight qualified directors and supported by sixteen cabin counselors (two to each group of the eight camper cabins) and a support crew of four volunteers. Medical care is under the direction of a registered nurse and supported by a level two first aid waterfront director. All staff, counselors, and crew receive leadership training the week prior to the start of the children's camp and all have had criminal record checks and have been approved by the Cultus Lake United Church Camp Board of Directors.

LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Cultus Lake United Church Camp offers a dynamic training program for those aged 15 years and over who would like to volunteer at camp. All participants are trained in leadership skills and the responsibilities of being a volunteer. Leaders for our summer programs are selected on the basis of camp needs and maturity. Please note that participation in the Leadership Training Program does not guarantee that you will be chosen to lead.

REGISTRATION

To register your child for camp, please complete a registration form which can be found on our website at www3.telus.net/clucc or contact the camp registrar. Send this form in with your camp fees to the address on the form. You will be sent a receipt and further information regarding your child's stay at camp.

Please note that registration time is 4:00 p.m. on each Sunday and pickup time is 11:00 a.m. on each Friday.

REFUNDS

Campers unable to attend a camp session for any reason will receive a full refund less a \$50.00 administrative fee, provided that a written request is received by the camp registrar eight (8) days prior to the start of camp. NO REFUNDS will be issued if the cancellation is less than eight (8) days prior to the start of camp.



CAMP FACILITIES

This fully accredited camp is located on 15 acres at the Southeast end of Cultus Lake near Chilliwack, BC. The camp is located on a lake, in a park-like setting amongst large maple, fir, and cedar trees. The camp can accommodate 64 campers in 8 cabins.

When summer children's camp is not in session, Cultus Lake United Church Camp facilities are available for rent.
