

Small Water Systems Award

To recognize small water systems in British Columbia for initiatives that demonstrates outstanding effort in the delivery of safe drinking water

Copperdome Lodge Ltd. Pemberton BC

- Formerly an elementary school, then Outward Bound; now a Group Lodge facility catering to education, health and wellness, corporate and outdoor groups.
- Serves two buildings, up to 40 people
- Owner: Ian Porter of Vancouver, BC

- Challenges:
 - well is located 5 kms from a cattle stockyard. The area is subject to flooding with possible well contamination.
 - also potentially influenced by a potato testing laboratory
 - A sewage is field located on the other side of main building
 - alternative low-risk sources not readily available.
- Actions:
 - May 2006: Boil Water Advisory issued
 - October 2006: study performed by Dayton & Knight Ltd: determined application too small to justify *engineered system*.
 - February 2007: RFQ issued for acceptable packaged water system
 - May 2007: Filterco install a multiple barrier system including hyper-chlorination, contact chamber, sediment and carbon filtration, and UV disinfection.

- Results:
 - Water quality meets standards and improved aesthetics.
 - Solution was prompt, appropriate and affordable
 - System is straight forward to operate and maintain.
 - System approved without Engineering drawings
