The Chinook Section of the Illuminating Engineering Society is pleased to announce that Kimberly Szinger P.Eng, and member of this southern Alberta section of the IESNA has been elected to the position of Sr. Vice President of the Illuminating Engineering Society of North America and President of the Society for the year following the term as Senior Vice President.

Kim's term begins July 1, 2006 and her term as President begins July 1, 2007.

Kim will be one of only three women, in the 100-year history of this organization, to lead its Board of Directors and to manage the Society's \$4M annual budget and staff of 20.
