BURSARY APPLICATION INFORMATION

- The applicant is responsible for setting up an interview with a member of the Bursary Committee of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #142 (West Point Grey).
TO ARRANGE AN INTERVIEW CONTACT BRANCH #142 (604) 738-1120.

SECTION I: Student Information

- Print clearly or type all the information requested.
- You must reside in, or attend a secondary school in, our Branch Community and be a Canadian Citizen or a Landed Immigrant.

SECTION II: Post Secondary Information

- Provide the name and address of the Post Secondary Institution that you will be attending.
- The campus must be in Canada.
- Bursaries are awarded only to students attending facilities on a full time basis.
- \$1000.00 bursaries shall be awarded to the successful applicants.

SECTION III: Financial Information

- This section is **confidential** and must be completed at the Branch interview

SECTION IV: Confirmation of Eligibility

- The applicant is, or is eligible for or the child or grandchild of, an Ordinary member of the Royal Canadian legion.

SECTION V: Comments of Interviewer

The applicant must bring the following to the Branch interview:

- Proof of eligibility according to Section IV .
- A letter of the aims and objectives written by the applicant.
- A record of community and school service and activities.

Note: Transcripts, photographs, reference letters or any other scholastic achievements are not necessary as bursaries are awarded on the basis of financial need.

The Interviewer should:

- Be sure applicant is at the right Branch.
- Be sure proper documentation is presented.
- Provide specifics that will assist the Bursary Committee in their decisions.
- Use a separate page as necessary as to why you feel the applicant requires aid
- Ensure that the applicant has signed the form
- Be sure to sign the application form, your signature certifies that the applicant was interviewed.

The Deadline for applications and interviews is MAY 31 of the current year.

Note: If you are a successful applicant, you will receive a letter of offer by June 15 of each year.

- Read carefully and follow the instructions.
- **You may be disqualified if you have received an additional award of equal or greater value than our bursary.**
- An award means money that you do not have to repay; student loans do not fall into this category.
