Statement of Principle

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities
- requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment
- ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment, and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare
- increasing education in training and horsemanship practices
- requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions
- reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

Please Read Carefully

-Entries open May 6th and close May 27th. Early entries will be penalized.

-If this is the first time you have competed with LIEC in the 2009 season, please attach proof of your EC Sports License and your HCBC membership. If the Owner is different from the Rider, please send proof of HCBC Membership and EC Sports License. Incomplete Entry Forms will be processed last.

-There is a non-refundable Administration Fee of 5\$/day for each horse/rider combination. Cancellations received by 5 PM on May 27th are entitled to a refund of Entry Fees as per LIEC General Rules. The Entry Secretary must be notified of any cancellations prior to the day of competition; on the day of competition please notify the Show Secretary if you need to cancel.

-Each horse/rider combination may enter two tests per day in total in any two consecutive levels or two tests plus Freestyle. **Each horse/rider combination may be limited to two classes or one day of showing depending on the number of entries.** Please indicate which day you would prefer if you are planning to ride both days and list tests in order of preference. Priority of entries will be determined by date and time of postmark and may be limited to LIEC members. Use a separate Entry Form for each horse and each day of competition. No drop off entries accepted.

-The Entry Form must be signed by the Person Responsible who must be an EC Sport License holder. In the case of junior entries, parents or guardians are entitled to sign their child's entry form without holding an EC Sport Licence, provided they agree to abide by the rules and penalties contained in the Rulebook. (Article A214.2)

-No cross entry between divisions. No cross entry between Walk/Trot Test B and any other class except Training Level Test 1. Hors Concours entries are not permitted. There will be an extra charge of \$10 for late entries.

-Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds be selected for medication control testing.

-Braiding is expected. Dress Code is as per EC (Dressage) Rules Article E 4.1.4. Please go to www.equinecanada.ca for current rules and dressage tests.

- Anyone wishing to longe their horse is required to check at the Show Office beforehand.

-The gate at A will remain open throughout the competition.

-Competitors only are allowed in the Competition and Warm Up area from 5 PM Friday June 5th until close of show. Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times when mounted.

-Rosettes will be awarded through 6th place. If there is only one rider in the class, placing will be determined by percentage. Trophies will be awarded to the Junior, Senior and Open horse/rider combinations who achieve the highest average score of 2 technical tests, Walk/Trot and Freestyle scores excluded. Trophies will also be awarded to the horse/rider combination who achieves the highest score in a Freestyle; to the LIEC Member with the highest score in a technical test, excluding Walk/Trot and Freestyle; and to the horse/rider combination with the highest score in a test Third Level or equivalent and above.

-The Show Office will open 45 minutes before start of show.

-Stabling will be available after 5PM on Friday. Riders wishing to enter grounds before this time must make arrangements to rent ring space with the Saanich Fairground.

-All horse trailers must be parked in the space provided behind the indoor arena. Please obey all directional signs. Overnight campers, trailers and RVs are required to park/pitch tents between the 4H Barn and the tower which provides electrical hook-ups. Fees (\$25/day) will be payable to Saanich Fairground on a separate cheque and are due when you pick up your competition number.

-All dogs must be on leashes.

-All competitors are expected to volunteer or provide someone who can do so in their place.

-Times will be posted by 8PM Thursday June 4th on <http://www3.telus.net/liec> and will be emailed to the LIEC membership or may be obtained by calling the Entry Secretary (Dianne Moore 250 652 5189). **Please be prepared to ride 30 minutes before allotted times.**

-Competitors are required to abide by the Code of Ethics of the Lower Island Equestrian Club. Please refer to 2008 LIEC General Rules and Show Information. **All decisions of the Show Committee are final.**

JUNEBUG 2009 STABLING INFORMATION

Stabling is available at a cost of \$25.00 per 24 hour period from 5 PM to 5 PM or portion thereof. The appropriate fee plus a separate "Clean Stall" deposit cheque of \$25.00 must accompany the Entry Form and only one clean stall deposit is required if stabling for 2 nights.
