

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

These shows are presented by the Pacific Pinto Horse Association and approved by the Pinto Horse Association of America, Inc, (PthA). The prize list is based on the rules and regulations in the PthA rule book, current edition. EVERY CLASS HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES OF THE PTHA AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE. Any revision or correction of these rules in the PthA rule book will automatically be included as a part of this prize list.

### **STALLS & TACKROOMS:**

a) Show/Main barn is reserved for FULL SHOW exhibitors only. b) No 1-day stalls will be issued for the show barn. c) Stabling is NOT available before Aug 9 @ 8am.

Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Rider and horse shall be subject to the constitution and rules of PthA. It shall further agree that every horse and rider/handler is eligible as entered and shall accept as final the decision of the show officials. It also agrees that the PthA, Pacific Pinto Horse Association and the Lower Fraser Valley Exhibition Association shall not be held responsible in any manner for loss of damage to any horses exhibited, nor any owner, exhibitor, handler or party affiliated to, nor loss or damage to any property or properties associated with these aforementioned articles. The signing of the entry form so stipulates acceptance of this agreement.

### **SHOW MANAGEMENT:**

The show management reserves the right to reject any entry (rider, handler, exhibitor, trainer or coach) it deems advisable in the best interest of the show. The show management reserves the right to exclude from the show grounds any horse or rider showing objectionable behaviour without being held liable for damage or compensation.

### **REGISTRATION:**

All horses, ponies and miniature horses MUST be registered with the PthA. The original papers or a photocopy of both sides of the registration papers must be presented at the show office at the time of check-in, prior to receiving a show number. Please enclose a copy of your registration papers, and membership/amateur card with your entries to ease the check in process. Those exhibitors that have leased horses, ponies or miniature horses must send a copy of the PthA lease agreement. REGISTRATION WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE SHOW FROM THE SECTOR DIRECTOR. ### **SUBSTITUTION:**

No substitutions of horses, ponies or minis may be made after the closing of entries without the express permission of the show secretary; a signed Vet certificate of disability must be presented at the time.

### **OUT OF PROVINCE EXHIBITORS:**

**U.S EXHIBITORS:** Be sure to check with your vet in plenty of time for your papers to be returned before you leave for Canada. At this time, horses may enter and exit Canada at any border crossing without a vet check. This could change at any time. Be sure to check with the border crossing of your choice before you leave home in case of temporary restrictions.

**REQUIRED PAPERWORK:** *Current USDA Health Certificate, Coggins Certificate, proof of ownership. For further info: Dr.Ron Olson - 604-666-7500*

### **REFUNDS:**

No entry fees will be refunded without a vet certificate. Vet outs must be received by the Show committee within 3 days of the end of the show. Office fee of \$25.00 will be retained.

### **DRUGS AND MEDICATION:**

No horse, Pony or Mini shall be shown in any class at a recognized show if it has been administered any forbidden substance in any manner or form. See PthA rule book for clarification of forbidden substances. RANDOM DRUG TESTING MAY OCCUR AT THESE SHOWS.

### **TWO MINUTE GATE:**

In classes in which animals compete collectively, after the warning is issued the in gate will be closed two (2) minutes after the last horse enters the arena. Exhibitors will be reminded and warned when classes are about to be closed. IT IS UP TO THE EXHIBITOR TO ARRIVE AT THE IN GATE ON TIME FOR THEIR CLASSES.

### **ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT:**

Exhibitors are required to use the correct equipment, attire, and number to enter the arena to be judged. equipment & attire will be checked. See PthA rule book for clarification. GROOMS FOR IDEAL PINTO

CLASSES ARE REQUESTED TO BE CLEAN AND NEAT, WEARING LONG PANTS AND SHIRTS WITH SLEEVES.

**JUDGES:**

NO ONE shall approach the judges with regard to a decision unless he obtains permission from the Show Committee, who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place. Judges' placings will be posted. The show committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one officially designated in the prize list. Judges decision is final.

**PROTESTS:**

Protests covering any occurrence within the horse show must be made in writing to the Show Committee, addressed to the Show Manager, and accompanied by a \$200.00 protest fee within 12 hours of the occurrence. This sum will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

**CAMPER HOOKUPS /HOTELS:**

Camper hookups are available at the show grounds. All overnight camping/tenting, hooked or not, will be charged for. Please pay for your RV/camping on your stabling form.
