see me.

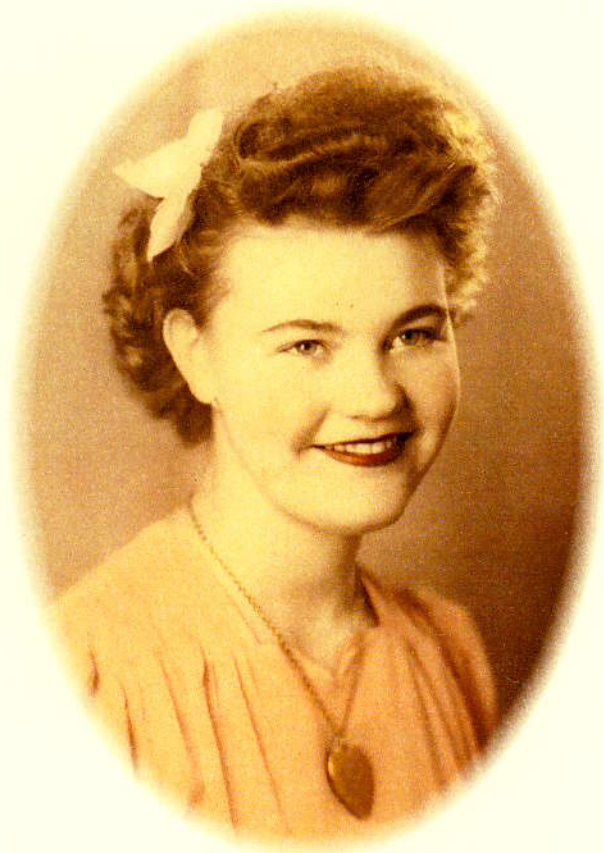
Talk to me – tell me
