WARNING: By signing this you also give up all rights to sue

TO: Bent Spoke Adventure Racing (hereinafter collectively called "Company") and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA (hereinafter called "Province")

In consideration of the Company for my being permitted to go on a 3 day mountain biking challenge on lands owned by the Province or elsewhere, I agree to this release from liability, waiver of claims and agreement not to sue and I agree to assume the dangers and risks of mountain biking some of which are listed below (collectively "this Agreement").

I waive any and all claims I may now and in the future have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Company, and representatives (collectively "its staff") or the Province for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss sustained by me as a result of my participation in the Company mountain bike challenge due to any cause whatsoever, including, without limitation, negligence on the part of the Company, its staff, or the Province.

I recognize that this is in no way a guided event. The Company has facilitated the bringing together of likeminded individuals to participate in a mountain biking challenge. Fees are for meals, accommodation and information provided. The Company will not be held liable for any errors or omissions within the information or materials provided. The Company will not be liable for events or circumstances resulting from any errors or omissions.

I am aware mountain biking has certain dangers and risks, some of which include:

1. MOUNTAINOUS AND STEEP TERRAIN - where a fall, may cause injury or death. In addition, the mountainous areas used for mountain biking have areas and steep slopes which in their natural state have many dangerous obstacles and hazards which may also be hidden or covered by snow. Some of these obstacles and hazards include glacier crevasses, ice and snow cornices, trees, tree stumps, creeks, rocks, boulders, forest deadfall, holes and depressions, and varying and difficult snow and climbing conditions. These mountainous areas may also have dangerous, man-made obstacles and hazards which may include logging or other roads, steep road banks, fences and other structures. The areas used for mountain biking may not have been traveled previously and are not regularly patrolled or examined. Communication in this mountain terrain is always difficult and, in the event of an accident, rescue and medical treatment may not be available;
2. AVALANCHES, ROCK FALL OR ICE FALL - which can frequently occur in the mountain terrain used for mountain biking and may be caused by natural forces including steepness of slopes, snow or ice depth, instability of the snowpack or rock or glacier, or changing weather conditions, or by bikers, or by aircraft or helicopter or the failure of any reason of the Company or its staff to predict whether the terrain is safe for wilderness backpacking or where or when an avalanche, rock fall or ice fall or may not occur;
3. WEATHER - weather conditions may be extreme and can change rapidly without warning;
4. WILD ANIMALS - which are unpredictable in nature and may attack bikers;
5. COMPANY, ITS STAFF AND OTHERS - the conduct, including negligence, of the Company, its staff and of all others.

I accept all the dangers and risks of mountain biking and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting there from.

I acknowledge that the enjoyment and excitement of a mountain biking challenge is derived in part from travelling in wild, rugged and uncontrolled environments and that the inherent risks of mountain biking contribute to such enjoyment and excitement.

In entering into this Agreement I am not relying on any oral, written or visual representations or statements made by the Company, including those in any brochures, printed literature, or electronic literature, or by its staff or by the Province, to induce me to go take part in the mountain biking challenge.

I confirm that I am of the full age of nineteen years and that I have read and understand this Agreement prior to signing it and agree that this Agreement will be binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrator, and successor.

I agree that this Agreement shall be governed by in all respects by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia .
