



## MMHA Rep A1 Tryouts 2011/2012 Season

### General Information

The Fee for Rep Tryouts will be \$40. Each player attending rep tryouts will receive 4 one hour ice times. No Player will be permitted to step on the ice without first being registered with MMHA. **NO registration will be accepted at Rep Tryouts.**

Following the 4<sup>th</sup> ice time a list of (19min-22max) skaters and (2min-4max) goalies will be posted at the arena. These players will continue on in the rep A1 pool until the final team selections are made. All players not listed will carry on to regular player evaluations.

Final Rep A1 selections will be targeted to be made by Sept 15<sup>th</sup> 2011.

Rep Selections are very subjective and what one person may see in a player may not be what the coach wants to make up the team, not to mention the proper chemistry on the team. This is generally the hardest time of the year for coaches as they do not like cutting players. It is part of their job to form the best teams they can, please respect and support them. All MMHA Coaches are volunteers and donate countless amounts of their personal time effort and expense, to coach your son or daughter.

Any questions regarding players, decisions or objections that any individual, family or parent may have should be directed **IN WRITING** to the president of MMHA. NO questioning coaches, asst coaches or team personnel will be tolerated with regards to rep selections and or cuts. Any and all volunteers during the rep process including executive members will be willing to help with any questions regarding format, times etc. They should not be approached or questioned regarding selections, rankings, or other issues of that nature.

All players and families wishing to play rep hockey this year should attend rep tryouts. Any player not able to attend rep tryouts but wishes to tryout must write a letter to MMHA executive explaining why they cannot attend. This letter must be received before rep tryouts commence. All letters will be reviewed by the MMHA executive on a case by case basis. If warranted a player may be afforded an opportunity to tryout after the initial tryouts.

All players and or families considering playing rep hockey this year should be aware that Rep Hockey is a greater commitment both financially and of each players time. Practices are mandatory, teams play on average 2 games per week, one being an away game. Teams generally enter 3-4 tournaments per year which you will be expected to pay extra for or participate in fundraising.



## Player / Goalie Evaluation

All players and goalies will be evaluated taking all relevant hockey factors into consideration. It will be the head coach's responsibility to compile the initial list of players that he feels makes up the best group to move forward in the tryout process.

After the initial tryout process players that move forward will continue to be evaluated until the final selections are made. During this phase of the tryouts exhibition games can be played and coaches will determine which kids play best where and how each individual may best fit into the team. These selections tend to be the most subjective of all, as well as the most difficult for the coaches. It is important that all parties involved respect the protocols referred to earlier and any disputes are only brought forward in writing to the MMHA VP in charge of that division. **VP contact information is listed below.**
