Halloween Safety Tips

Walk with other kids, or have your parents walk with you.

Stay on the sidewalks and don't cut across people's yards.

Cross at intersections and obey traffic lights.

Make-up is better than a mask (a mask with small eye holes makes it hard to see).

Don't go into other people's houses. Stay outside.

Go only to houses that are will lit.

Wear bright, reflective colors so that drivers can see you when it gets dark.

(Remember that just because you can see the card doesn't mean the driver can see you)

Be courteous and say "Thank you" to the people who give out treats.



If you see something suspicious, throw it away.

Make sure the treats are in the original wrapper.

Don't eat homemade treats unless you know the people who gave it to you.

Carry identification, including your name, address and phone number.

Trick-or-treat only in your own neighbourhood.

Take a flashlight along. After dark, this will help you see where you are going, and let drivers see you.

Wear costumes that are fireproof and not too long or too loose.

Have your parents check your treats before you eat any candy.
