Diagnostic Services

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- * Available in the Lakeland Area
- * Mobile Multidisciplinary Team for children and adults
- * Recommendations & Strategies
- * Comprehensive and professional
- * Giving the best information to individuals, families, caregivers, supports and organizations

Referrals:

The referral can be made by anyone, by simply calling the Centre.

Eligibility

- * Live in the Lakeland service area
- * Provincial or Federal Jurisdiction

Process

An application package is sent out to the family or referring body to complete. Once returned to the Centre, it is reviewed and any additional information needed is collected (with consent). Then, a clinic date and location is determined for clinic. The actual clinic takes about half a day for children and a bit longer for adults.

On clinic Day

The child or adult will participate in a variety of assessments. The caregivers and supports will be interviewed to determine their needs. Families/Individuals will leave with a diagnosis, and a hand written list of recommendations.

Post Clinic

- * A detailed report will follow to the family, family physician, and referring body.
- * Follow Up Support is provided to the individuals, families, and support agencies to meet the recommendations set by the diagnostic team.



FEES

The fees cover all of the above. No individual or family is expected to cover the costs of the service - we approach agencies that would benefit the most.

- * \$1000 per child
- * \$2000 per adult

These fees cover the costs currently not covered by the Government of Alberta.
