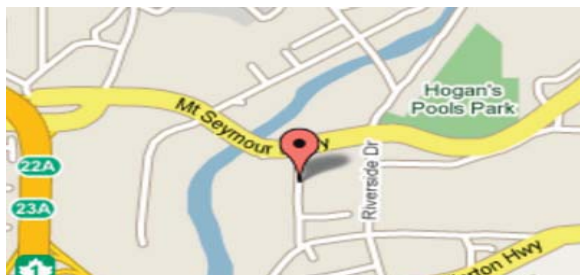

Gabe Garcia pastors a large Hispanic congregation in San Diego, California. His studies include Bachelor of Science in Business at the University of Arizona, Masters of Business at the University of Rochester, Pastoral Studies at L.I.F.E. Pacific University, and Masters of Religion at Reformed Theological Seminary. Currently, he



oversees AMiA's efforts and outreach in Ministry to the Hispanics. Not only has the local ministry in San Diego, California seen great strides in discipleship and evangelism, but he has been directly involved both personally in the planting of churches, and also in the development of the leadership for several new congregations, both Anglican and non-denominational in Southern California, Arizona, and Colombia, South America. Among the areas for which Gabe is passionate about is seeing every believer in the local congregations fulfill their God-designed purposes including becoming a beacon for the Gospel of Jesus Christ in their community by being witnesses of the Biblical Truths. He currently lives in San Diego, California along with his wife and family.

William Beasley is a graduate of Wheaton College and Yale Divinity School and has been involved in starting new congregations in the Chicago area. He also supports church plants led by catechists at Northwestern University and in Kenosha. He works with the Redeemer Family of Churches and oversees the Anglican Mission Midwest Network.



William has a real heart for Rwanda, especially how we can learn from Rwanda's emphasis on raising up lay catechists and planting churches. He has a passion for Jesus' prayer in John 17 that we would be one as the Father and the Son are one that the world would believe. Christian Unity for William has to do with releasing God's people into mission.

To be around William is to catch fire with a fresh Kingdom vision for reaching the world for Christ. He has challenged the Chicago AMiA congregations to pray towards reaching one in 100 Chicago citizens, bringing them to Christ and into God's church. William and his family live in Glenview, IL.
