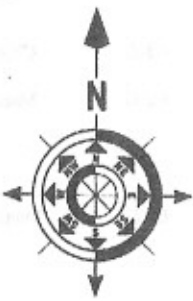

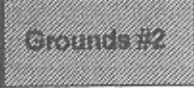
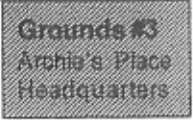

DEFINITION OF STAKES

PUPPY For dogs 6 months of age, but not over 1 year on the day of the trial
JUNIOR For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial
QUALIFYING For dogs who have never won 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th or
a certificate of merit in an Open All-Age stake, nor a
1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th in a Amateur All age stake nor
have won 5 Qualifying stakes
OPEN ALL AGE... For dogs over the age of 6 months
AMATEUR ALL AGE...For dogs over the age of 6 months if handled by a person who is an Amateur
as determined by the Field Trial Committee
