3. Entries CLOSE Thursday, August 27, 2009.
4. Draw will take place at 7:00 PM on Thursday, August 27, 2009 at the home of the Field Trial Secretary. All dogs will run in order drawn. In All Age Stakes, rotation will be used.
5. A separate entry form for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required. PLEASE USE THE OFFICIAL C.K.C. ENTRY FORMS SUPPLIED, OR COPY OF SAME.
6. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry fee (and, if applicable, Listing fee of \$8.40 which includes GST) in full. A Listing fee of \$8.40 per dog per event is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.
7. **No phone entries.**

SCRATCHES will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered a "scratch" refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

DUCKS and/or PHEASANTS may be used in all stakes.

TROPHIES and STANDARD CKC ROSETTES will be awarded for all placings in each stake. Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded for all C.M.'s.

CAMPING and TRAILER PARKING available. No electrical hook ups, no water.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to all parties concerned. It shall also within ten days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated.

DEFINITION OF STAKES

PUPPY	For dogs not over 1 year on the day of the trial
JUNIOR	For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial
QUALIFYING	For dogs who have never placed or had a certificate of merit in an Open All Age stake, or placed in an Amateur All Age stake, or won 5 Qualifying stakes
AMATEUR ALL AGE	For dogs over the age of 6 months and handled by an Amateur as determined by the Field Trial Committee
OPEN ALL AGE	For dogs over the age of 6 months
