Excerpt from CKC Rules & Regulation for Hunt Test

Chap.18: Sec.7: “It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the Canadian Kennel Club any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.”

Valens Conservation Area is located on Regional Road 97, West of Highway 6. From the 401 go south on Highway 6 to Regional Road 97. Follow Regional Road 97 to just past Valens Road. The entry to Valens is on the right.

If you are coming from the 403, take the 403 to Highway 6. Go north on Highway 6 past Carlisle Road. Once through Freelton, Regional Road 97 will be on your left. Turn left onto RR 97 and follow the directions above.

Please note that a gate fee will be charged upon entry to Valens.
