



GROUNDS

The Pine Ridge area is situated in the picturesque rolling hills of Northumberland County. The scenic area has farmlands, hayfields, cereal crops and idle fields with natural cover. Ponds are both natural and man-made and are usually fringed with cattails or wild grasses. Very often, water entries may be viewed from great distances. These sites contain challenging hazards such as dead trees and logs or aquatic vegetation. In the fall of the year, fields may display high cover, grazed pastures or harvested crops. We have also found new properties to use in conjunction with existing test sites.
