Special note: Permission to hold this field trial in the Tunkwa Lake area has been granted by The Ministry of Environment. Securing this permission was very difficult to obtain and is granted conditionally. In order to maintain our ability to hold these events, it is imperative that all participants respect the grounds by keeping vehicles to designated roads only. The Ministry has asked that mid-week training be carried on so as not to disturb waterfowl or interfere with other persons using the area for hiking, bird-watching etc. Training should be avoided in areas where there is signage indicating “no training”. Respect private property and be courteous to other users. Future events will depend upon how well participants conduct themselves, both during the field trial events and afterward. Please, clean up after yourselves and pick up any garbage left behind by others.
