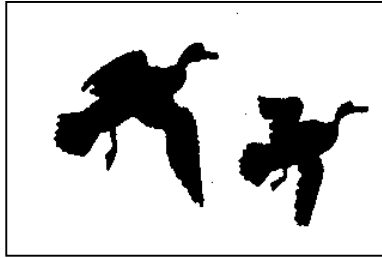

ENTRIES: Please complete one entry form per dog, per stake, per day in which you wish to enter your dog(s). All entries must contain complete information as required by the CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full, and all listing fees (\$8.40 including GST) where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice. Scratches will be refunded for a bitch in season totally. All other scratches will be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion, other than a fee of \$5.00.

RULE 21.7 of the Field Trial Rules States: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

RULE 4.1.6 of the Field Trial Rules States: A trial secretary shall assume the responsibility of collecting all listing fees for the CKC, which shall be stated in the premium list."
