**GROUNDINGS**

The trial grounds are located about 35km (22 miles) SE of Saskatoon. See map. There WILL NOT be a lunch wagon, so bring your own food and drink.

**ENTRIES**

3. Entries CLOSE **Monday, June 22, 2009**
4. DRAW will take place at 8pm Tuesday, June 23 at the home of the Field Trial Secretary.  
All dogs will run in the order drawn.
5. **A separate entry form for EACH dog in EACH stake is required (Official CKC Entry Form)**
6. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee (and listing fee of \$8.51 if applicable) . The listing fee of **\$8.51 (GST included) per dog per event** is payable unless the entered dog has a CKC individual registration number or an ERN number.
