Please Note: Should number of entries require it, some stakes may take more than one day to complete.

All-Age Judges will impose a system of rotation pursuant to Rule 6.6.1c. CKC Rule Book – 2005 edition.

Starting Numbers: The order of running in the Open and Amateur stakes shall be in the order of the draw beginning with the dog determined using the S&P/TSX Composite Index closing number on the Tuesday preceding the trial. We will advise all contestants with E-mail address of the starting number on Wednesday, August 12, 2009.

Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrous, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Field Trial Secretary prior to the start of the stake to qualify for a refund.

Any person, participating in any capacity at the Field Trial held under these CKC rules, shall not be subject to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively enforced. On report to the trial giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within 10 days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.

CLOSING AND DRAW: Entries will close on Friday, August 8, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. The draw will be held at the residence of the Field Trial Secretary the following evening. Please make cheques payable to: **SUNPOKE HUNTING RETRIEVER CLUB, INC.** All fees are listed in **Canadian Currency**. Cheques must be dated no later than **August 8, 2009**. Outside competitors should allow time for postal delays. Late entries or post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Send one entry form per dog per stake, include all titles (old & new) and print information clearly. Thank you.

(CKC fees for 2006) Every Canadian dog must be individually registered with the CKC, litter registration numbers are not acceptable. All foreign dogs, if not individually registered with the CKC or have an ERN, must provide the foreign registration, pay the required listing fee and apply to the CKC for an ERN.
