### ENTRIES:

1. Make all cheques payable to the Winnipeg Field Trial Club. Cheques dated no later than the closing date. Please mail early.

3. **Entries Close Wednesday, June 17, 2009.**
4. Draw at 8:00 PM on Wednesday, June 17, 2009 at the home of the Hunt Trial secretary.  
 All dogs will run in order drawn. Rotation may be used.
5. A separate entry form for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required. PLEASE USE THE OFFICIAL C.K.C. ENTRY FORMS SUPPLIED, OR COPY OF SAME.
6. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry fee (and, if applicable, Listing fee of \$8.40 which includes GST) in full. A Listing fee of \$8.40 per dog per event is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.
7. **No phone entries.**

**SCRATCHES** will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered, "NO SHOW" refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

**DUCKS, PHEASANTS and/or SNOW GEESE** may be used in all stakes.

**CLOTHING:** Competitors, judges and throwers should wear dark or customary hunting attire which adequately reflects waterfowling or upland hunting.

**STANDARD CKC ROSETTES** will be awarded for all dogs qualifying in the Hunt Tests.

**CAMPING and TRAILER PARKING** available. No electrical hook ups; no water.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to all parties concerned. It shall also within ten days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated.

### DEFINITION OF STAKES

JUNIOR HUNT TEST	For dogs over the age of 6 months that have not received a qualifying score in a Senior or Master Hunt Test.
SENIOR HUNT TEST	For dogs over the age of 6 months that have not received a qualifying score in a Master Hunt Test.
MASTER HUNT TEST	For dogs over the age of 6 months
