

Saskatoon Gun Dog Club NAVHDA Test Dates Announced

The Saskatoon Gun Dog Club (NAVHDA Chapter) has been approved to hold a 2 day NAVHDA-sanctioned test event in September on Saturday the 12th and Sunday the 13th.

The event will be held at the Saskatoon Retriever Club grounds at Bradwell (east of Saskatoon). To date 8 entries have been submitted from within the Saskatoon club (7 UT & 1 NA) and the test is now open to members from outside associations to join us, if there is interest in testing a dog or dogs this year.

Capacity for testing is limited, according to NAVHDA judging guidelines, so test entry priority will be given to applicants according to the date that the official NAVHDA test entry forms and a cheque to cover fees has been received. Once the test is full a waiting list will be initiated.

Test fees are the same as those charged by the Wild Rose Chapter, as indicated below:

- NAVHDA Int'l Members: NA \$110 UPT \$135 UT \$135
- Non-NAVDA Int'l Members: NA\$130 UPT \$155 UT \$155
- There will be an additional one-time fee of \$27 for handlers who are not 2009 paid members of the Saskatoon Gun Dog Club
- Please remember that dogs **must be** NAVHDA registered to be tested (www.navhda.org).
